In addition, Googling the address above or ABC Treehouse Gallery will bring up those in the close vicinity of the workshop venue. Another reference point is a main thoroughfare called 'Spui'. Any address containing this will be very helpful. We are including a map of the immediate area for your reference. The easiest way to get to Spui and the venue, if you are not in walking distance, is by tram. Trams numbered 1, 2, 5, 24, 13, 17 all stop there.
